



Wreath Decorating Tips

Important Note: Some of the decorating materials can attract small critters like mice and chipmunks. Please be mindful of where you store your materials until you are ready to decorate. Do not leave in your garage or outdoor spaces.

- Decorating doesn't require a lot of space and it doesn't have to be messy! All you need is a small flat surface or a place to hang your wreath. Needles and material debris can be collected in a towel under your workspace or swept up when finished.
- Decorating your wreath on a vertical surface is much easier than trying to add items while the wreath is lying flat. Hang your wreath on a nail or wall hook.
- Use the provided covered wire to hang your wreath. Feed through center of wreath and twist ends tightly to create a loop to hang.
- Odd numbers are more effective at capturing your gaze. Arrange items in groups of 3, 5 or 7.
- Work in a clockwise direction following the wreath's branches. This will help the wreath's design to 'flow'.

No glue gun necessary! How do you attach materials? Some items with strong stems can be stuck directly in your wreath and will hold in place. Long floral wire and floral wire picks will help items without stems. Use the wire to wrap around your decorations and insert into the wreath to hold in place. Hot glue can be used for heavier items if you have it at home.

Do you need to shape your wreath? Use scissors to trim any edges.
